



"I was a stay-at-home dad caring for our two babies while my wife Samantha worked full time as a midwife, and later a labour and delivery nurse. Once our kids were a little bigger, I felt the urge to start something of my own, and I had restaurant and cooking experience from both my earlier years in Nepal and later on when I moved to

I think people everywhere love dumplings, but when I started my business 13 years ago, no one here had ever heard of momos. People seemed to love them and started coming back week after week to order them. Also, I think it's the sauce too. Everyone loves the sauce!

Momos are a very popular street food in Nepal. My personal recipe is one I created myself. I started with just one kind, pork, then over time added chicken, vegan and water buffalo momos to my menu."

Yam Gurung is a native of Nepal who moved to Canada at the age of 22 after he met his wife while she was visiting his country. His restaurant, Momos at the Market, is one of the original vendors at the Western Fair District farmers market. Yam also has another storefront at 630 Dundas Street. Spare time isn't something he has much of, but when he does have it, Yam enjoys gardening and being outdoors.




















Hello,
