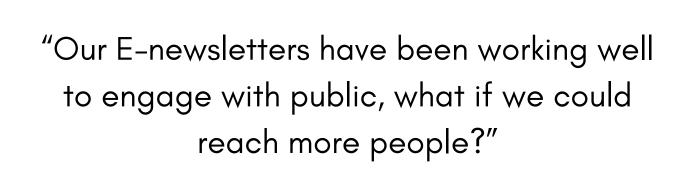


Begin with Audit & Analysis
