Downtown Economic Trends

Ontario's Food & Beverage Sector

- Sales grew 3.4% in December 2024, hitting
 \$3.4 billion
- Limited-service restaurants (fast food, takeout, cafés) up 8%
- Special food services (catering, event-based dining) up 5%
- Drinking places (bars, pubs, breweries) up 1%

Ontario's Job Market - Tourism

- •Total employment in Ontario grew 2%
- Tourism-related jobs surged to 9%
- •Travel Services +72%
- •Arts, Entertainment & Recreation +18%
- •Food & Beverage +11%

Key Challenges for Downtowns

·Public Realm Investment:

Need for upgrades to sidewalks, lighting, and public areas.

- •Business Retention: Rising costs and shifting consumer habits impact small businesses.
- •Tourism Development:

Ongoing investment in events and marketing is crucial to attracting visitors.


Top Mistakes to Avoid in Grant Applications
